The labeling, referred to above, submitted in connection with the registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable, provided that you make the following changes:

1. Under "Environmental Hazards";

Add "This pesticide is toxic to fish."

2. Under "Pesticide Storage";

Add the following statements:

"Keep only in the original container in a cool, dry, well-ventilated place away from ignition source, heat or flame. Avoid prolonged storage at temperatures in excess of 95 °F. Protect containers from physical damage and against contamination."

3. Under "Warranty Limitations and Disclaimer";

Add "To the fullest extent permitted by law," before "Dintec Agrichemicals EXPRESSLY . . . IMPLIED WARRANTIES."
