DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Solely intended as a Microbiological Water Purifier for use with Lil'Pure, Porta'Pure, and Porta'Mate Water Purification Systems.

Refer to accompanying Operations & Service Manual for the use directions.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store this product in nonmetallic containers resistant to the corrosive action of Iodine, such as glass or polyethylene containers. Keep moist (preferably with deionized water), by storing resin beads with a small layer of water above the settled resin. Keep away from direct sunlight or excessive heat. Do not allow resin to freeze. Do not store in open or unlabeled containers.

DISPOSAL OF UNUSED RESIN: This resin contains Iodine (I₂), which is corrosive to most metals. Do not dispose resin in sewers or storm drains. Place in non-metallic containers and dispose in sanitary landfill approved for pesticide disposal.

DISPOSAL OF USED RESIN CARTRIDGE: Securely wrap used cartridge in newspaper and discard in trash.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is toxic to fish. Do not discharge into lakes, streams, ponds, or public water, unless in accordance with a NPDES permit. For guidance, contact the regional office of the Environmental Protection Agency.
