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
The revised, updated Confidential Statement of Formula dated March 13, 1995, is in compliance with PR Notice 91-2, it agrees with the label and is acceptable.

For Infested Pools/Preventive Treatment

1. Clean Tile on Pool
2. Backwash Filter
3. Disconnect slide and automatic pool cleaner from pool support system
4. Adjust pH to 7.2-7.4 range
5. Raise chlorine residual to 3 ppm
6. Wait 15 minutes after adding chlorine
7. Add ALGAEDYN through skimmer at the rate of 8 oz. every 10 minutes until recommended dosage is reached. If pool has no skimmer, add ALGAEDYN below water level in front of return by squeezing bottle at the same rate mentioned above.
8. Keep filter in operation during treatment and for a minimum of 72 hours after treatment.
9. For best results, keep filter in operation until condition clears.
