The submission referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, to provide a revised label in response to our letter dated 1/11/2001, is **acceptable with the following label comments**. With your next regular amendment involving a label revision, you must make the following changes.

1. In the "Storage and Disposal" section, you must put your "General" information in the "Pesticide Disposal" section where it more logically fits. Then delete the title "General".
2. You must clarify on the label whether the product is intended only for each visible algal infestation control cycle as it occurs, or whether it is to be used weekly or at some frequency to control non-visible algae, after visible algae control is achieved.
3. You must clarify whether or not the product is intended for winterizing pools against algae, and provide use directions, if appropriate.
4. If the product, in its concentrated form, can sometimes stain pool surfaces, equipment, or clothing you must state this on the label.

A copy of the revised label, stamped "Accepted With Comments" is attached for your files.

### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

#### FOR INFESTED POOLS / PREVENTION TREATMENT

1. Clean Tile on Pool.
2. Backwash Filter.
3. Disconnect slide and automatic pool cleaner from pool support system.
4. Adjust pH to 7.2 — 7.4 range.
5. Raise chlorine residual to 3 ppm.
6. Wait 15 minutes after adding chlorine.
7. Add ALGAEDYN through skimmer at the rate of 8 oz. every 10 minutes until the recommended dosage is reached. If pool has no skimmer, add ALGAEDYN below water level in front of return by squeezing bottle at the same rate mentioned above.
8. Keep filter in operation during treatment and for a minimum of 72 hours after treatment.
9. For best results, keep filter in operation until condition clears.
