In the section titled "**DIRECTIONS FOR USE.....FOR FLEAS**", You may wish to interchange the position of the following two statements: (1) "Using easy applicator....", and (2) "Vacuum all areas thoroughly....". The current statement order which appears on the label indicates that the user should apply this product and immediately vacuum the area after treatment.

c. In the section titled "**TO CONTROL COCKROACHES....**", make the following spelling corrections:

(1) Correct the spelling of the term "**CONTROLL**".

(2) Correct the spelling of the term "dishwater". It is assumed that the term should read "dishwasher".

5. Submit one (1) copy of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions. A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

FOR FLEAS: Carpets: Using easy applicator apply to dry surfaces on carpet thoroughly and dispose of bag. Note: If a very high adult flea population exists, use a flea pesticide designed to kill adult fleas before using this product. Apply directly to carpet at the rate of one pound per 200 sq. feet. (16 mg/sq. in). Work powder deeply into carpet with a broom or rug rake. Any powder visible after application must be brushed or vacuumed removed. **Upholstery:** Remove loose cushions. Apply along creases and into the folds of cushions. Do not apply product to exposed fabric. Any product visible after application must be brushed or vacuumed removed.

TO CONTROL COCKROACHES, PALMETTOBUGS, ANTS, and SILVERFISH

1. Using easy applicator, create a barrier through which cockroaches and other insects cannot pass.
2. Apply liberally under and behind refrigerator, stoves, sink, dishwasher, water pipes, and tubs in kitchen and utility rooms.
3. Apply in cracks and crevices along baseboards and corner of cabinets, cupboards, and drawers.
4. Apply a line from corner to corner in rear of kitchen cabinets or drill 1/2" holes in cabinets in kitchen and bathrooms, dusting liberally.
5. Remove lower drawers in kitchen and bathroom cabinets, bedroom dresser drawers, and liberally dust into drawer wells and under bookshelves.
6. Apply into openings and void areas around plumbing, drains, water pipes, and other openings.
7. Any powder visible after application may be brushed into the cracks and crevices. Reapply as necessary. Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs.

NON-DOMESTIC USE (NON-EDIBLE PRODUCT AREAS ONLY):

Existing Construction to Control Cockroaches and Other Insects 1. When treating areas such as wall voids, soffits and sub-cabinet voids, dust liberally using dusting applicator. 2. In storerooms, dust into pits of dumbwaiters, elevator shafts and trash chutes. 3. In storerooms, dust behind boxes.

Care should be taken to avoid depositing the product onto exposed surfaces or introducing the material into the air. Avoid contamination of food or food processing surfaces.
