DETUR provides a physical barrier to feeding and oviposition and/or enhances knockdown when used in combination with other insecticides for the control of Whitefly on a variety of crops at any time during the growing season even as a pre-harvest insecticide up to and including the day of harvest. Use a rate of one percent (1%) at a minimum of one pint per acre in concentrate or dilute solutions with water and/or other ingredients following the most restrictive label. No label dosage rates may be exceeded. This product can not be mixed with any other product containing labeling prohibiting such mixing.

DETUR is compatible with high pressure and electrostatic equipment. Thorough and uniform crop coverage is required for adequate insect control. Repeat as needed to maintain control and/or after rain storms.

DETUR may be used in or on all raw agricultural commodities.

Shake well before using and agitate spray solution. Variations in water quality and tank mix partner may effect compatibility. Ground application only.

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
