**FIRST AID**

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE:  
READ ENTIRE LABEL BEFORE USING**

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

**WHERE TO USE:**

To control powdery mildew on plants in and around the home including, but not limited to, roses, flowers, foliage plants, ornamentals, shrubs, trees, and vegetables.

**HOW TO USE:**

Shake well. Adjust spray nozzle to give a coarse spray. Aim at spots of powdery mildew infection and spray thoroughly until wet. E-RASE Ready-To-Use is a contact control agent that requires thorough spray coverage to achieve control of powdery mildew. Shake E-RASE Ready-To-Use container frequently while using. If powdery mildew is still active 7 days after initial application, then reapply the product as directed above. While disease conditions exist apply the product every 7 to 14 days. Spray anytime powdery mildew is active, but no more than once a week. Apply weekly to help protect new growth.

Do not apply when temperatures drop below 50°F.

**IMPORTANT NOTE:** Complete wetting of foliage will be difficult to achieve on pubescent (hairy leaved) plants. Because of the pubescence, it will be necessary to continue spraying until the spray penetrates through the hairs and wets the actual upper surface of the leaf. Some plant species may be sensitive to E-RASE Ready-To-Use. Environmental factors significantly affect plant damage. E-RASE Ready-To-Use has been tested on numerous ornamental plants without toxic effects, however, not all species and varieties grown have been tested. To be sure no damage occurs to the plant, treat a small branch or a few leaves as directed above. Wait one day to check for plant damage to occur following test sprays on sensitive plants.

Shake well before using and shake spray solution frequently during use.

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:**

**DO NOT CONTAMINATE WATER, FOOD OR FEED BY STORAGE OR DISPOSAL:**

**PESTICIDE STORAGE:** Store product in original container in a cool (not in direct sunlight), dry, locked place out of reach of children. If product is stored below 50°F the wax component in the formula will solidify. Therefore, it will be necessary to warm the product to above 50°F to make it sprayable. Do not put product into food or drink containers. Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs. Store upright so that handles and spray nozzle are above the level of contents of container.

**PESTICIDE DISPOSAL:**

If empty: Do not reuse this container. Place in trash or offer for recycling if available.

If partly filled: Call your local solid waste agency or 1-800-CLEANUP for disposal instructions. Never place unused product down any indoor or outdoor drain.
