- (1) VETERINARIAN RECOMMENDED
- (2) PROFESSIONAL STRENGTH

e. Revise the statement **DIRECTIONS FOR APPLICATION** to read as follows:
DIRECTIONS FOR USE: It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

f. Revise the application rate to read "5-8 pounds of FLEA-B-GONE per 1000 square feet". An application rate lower than this must be supported by efficacy data.

g. Revise the statement "Using a carpet rake..." to read as follows: Using a carpet rake or a push broom, sweep powder deep into carpet fibers until no longer visible.

h. Delete the following statement from the product label: FLEA-B-GONE goes to work upon contact, with results beginning within 48 hours and complete effectiveness achieved within 3-5 weeks.

i. Correct the spelling of the word "SATISFACION" to read "SATISFACTION".

4. Submit one (1) copy of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions. A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.
