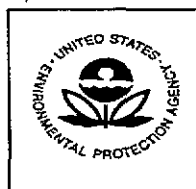

b. Display the ingredient statement on the bottle front in the following format:

c. The signal word WARNING must be displayed on the front panel.

- d. Include "Canada" in the company name and address.
- e. The Net Contents must be expressed as fluid ounces.
- f. Add the Heading "Directions for Use" to the Bottle Back panel and card back.
- g. Add to the Directions for use the following statement:
Do not squirt directly on face.
- h. To the bottle back panel and the card back add the title "PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS" before the statement READ ALL PRECAUTIONS.
- i. After the signal word WARNING add the statement "Keep out of eyes, lips, and mouth."
- j. Modify the "If swallowed" statement to match the label statement on MORFLEX DEET, your source product: If swallowed, drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. If person is unconscious, do not give anything by mouth and do not induce vomiting. Get medical attention.
- k. On the Sew-in label and the instruction card, convert the amounts to U.S. measures (teaspoons), which may be followed by the metric equivalents.
- l. On the Sew-in label, change "Precautions" to "Precautionary Statements" and add the following:
Do not wear treated garments under regular clothing.
After returning indoors, remove treated clothing and return to storage bag. Wash with soap and water any skin that was in direct contact with treated garment.
- m. Add to the sew-in label a Disposal statement as follows:
Disposal: Wrap treated garment in several layers of newspaper and dispose of in trash.
- n. Delete the EPA registration number from the sew-in label, the bag and the instruction card. EPA is registering Skeeto-Ban Insect Repellent. EPA is not registering the jacket and pants, the bag, or the instruction card. These items are considered part of the master label for Skeeto-Ban Insect Repellent.
- o. Add to the bag a disposal statement as follows:
Disposal: Wrap bag in several layers of newspaper and dispose of in trash.

- p. Delete from the bag the following: "and most biting insects". You must specify the insects.
- q. Change "leaflet" to "instruction card."
- r. Delete the word "Caution" each time it appears with "flammable." Since the signal word for this product is "warning", the use of the word "caution" detracts from the proper signal word.

3. Submit two copies of the revised final printed label for the record. A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

4. The lower limit on your confidential statement of formula (CSF) is not in accordance with the regulations at 40 CFR 158.175. These regulations require that the lower limit be no lower than 97% (unless you submit a justification for the lower limit). You must revise your CSF for the record or submit a justification.

5. Enclosed is a copy of the efficacy review. The reviewer has requested that you submit information on the approximate area of mesh cloth for each size of clothing.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

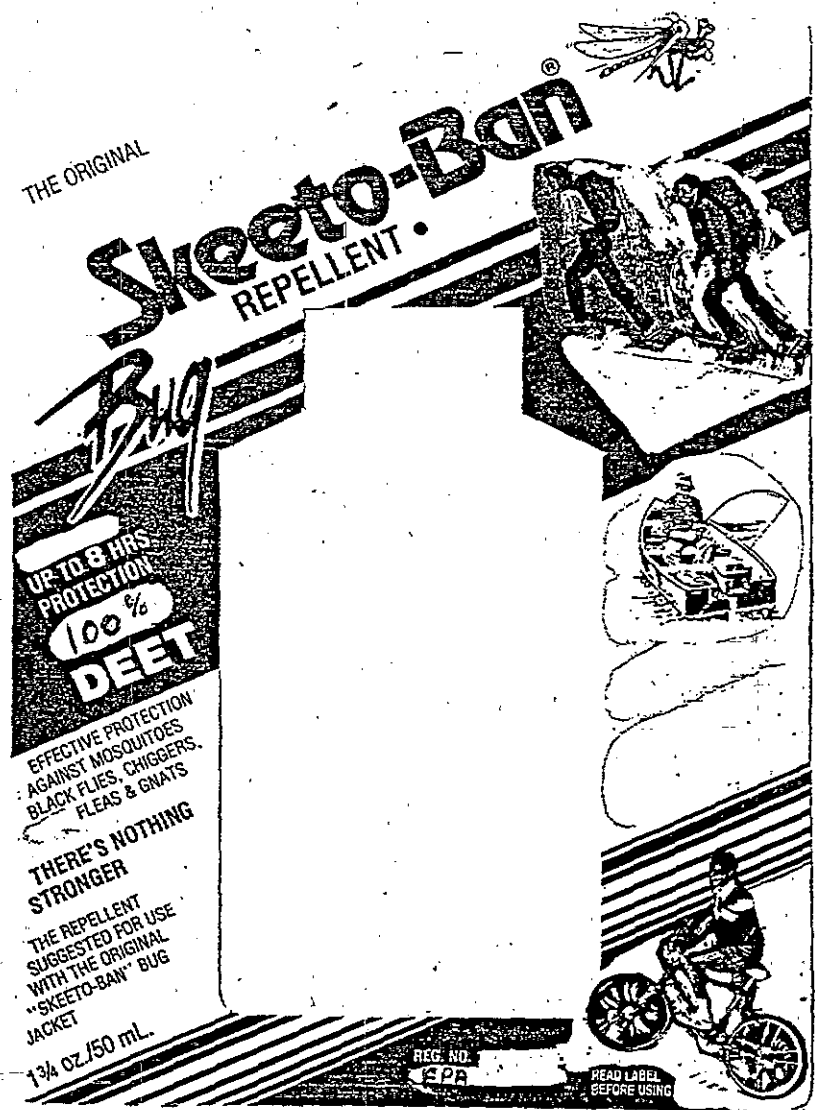

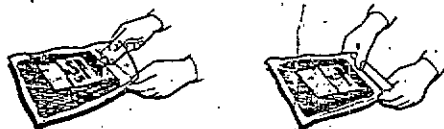

RETREATING
