


- e. Revise the statement **STATEMENTS OF PRACTICAL TREATMENTS**, which appears on the front panel of the product label, to read as follows: **STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT**.
 - f. The word **HAZARD** should be changed to **HAZARDS** in the statement **HAZARD TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS**.
 - g. Delete the statement of practical treatment which appears on the side panel of the proposed label. This section is not necessary at this time. **Do not delete** the **STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT** which appears on the front label panel.
 - h. Revise the word "label" which appears in the statement "It is a violation...." to read as "labeling".
 - i. Delete the two words "and mate" which appear in the statement which begins "Work powder deeply into fibers...".
3. Please provide the basis for the information which appears on the **Confidential Statement of Formula** in boxes 7, 8, and 9.
4. Revise the **Confidential Statement of Formula** to include *up, er and lower certified limits*, which will appear in columns 14a and 14b.
5. Submit one (1) copy of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions. A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

areas, you may apply at the rate of one
pound per 200 square feet (16 mg/sq.in).
Work powder deeply into fibers and rake
with a broom or rug rake. Any powder
visible after application MUST be brushed
into carpet fibers or removed.

ALLOW THREE TO FIVE WEEKS FOR MAXIMUM
FLEA CONTROL. REAPPLY AS NECESSARY.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Keep container closed when not in
