It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

USE RESTRICTIONS: Children and pets should not be in treatment area until after application is completed. Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs. Avoid contamination of ornamental plants.

PRIOR TO APPLICATION: If carpets need to be cleaned, do so before application. Carpets must be completely dry before application. Before treatment, vacuum thoroughly all carpets. Fish tanks and animal cases should be covered during application.

To control Fleas: Apply directly on all carpet areas concentrating on areas where pets frequently traffic or sleep. Treat closets, area rugs, and under furniture that does not sit flush on the floor. Apply at a rate of 1lb per 600 square feet (5.25 mg/sq. in.). Brush powder into carpet fibers with a broom or rug rake. Visible product remaining after application must be brushed into fibers by further grooming or removing by vacuuming. Powder may also be worked into furniture wells under cushions. Do not apply to exposed fabric.

Resume normal vacuuming after 4 days. Allow four to six weeks for maximum flea control.

Note: If high adult flea population exist or develops after treatment, you may apply a pesticide designed to kill adults fleas.

To control cockroaches, ants, silverfish apply liberally scattering under and behind refrigerator, stove, sink, dishwasher, washing machine, dryer, water pipes, electrical conduits. Also apply in cracks and crevices along baseboards and corners of cabinets, cupboards, and closets. Remove all lower drawers in kitchen and bathroom cabinets. Also remove dresser drawers and chest of drawers. Scatter liberally in drawers ells. Reapply as necessary. Any powder visible after applycation must be brushed into crack and crevices or removed. Apply only in areas inaccessible to children and pets. Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs.

Directions for applying as a mop to control cockronches: Add 1 cup of powder to each gallon of mass water. Apply to floor areas only. Make obly mough for each application supplemental treatment only.

CRACK AND CREVICE TREATMENT

Food area application limited to crack and crevice treatment only: Includes areas for receiving, storage, packing (canning, bottling, . wrapping, boxing,) preparing, edible waste storage and enclosed processing systems (mills, dairies, edible oils, syrups). Serving areas (when food is exposed and facility is in operation) also would be considered a food area.

Apply in small amounts directly into cracks and crevices using a bulbous duster or other suitable equipment capable of applying insecticide directly into cracks and crevices, in points between different elements of construction, between equipment and floors, opening leading to voids and hollow spaces in walls, equipment legs and bases, conduits, motor housing and electrical switch boxes where cockroaches hide.
