DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

For best results use in confined areas outdoors. Keeps area free from mosquitoes for up to 4 hours in still air. Repels mosquitoes quick!

Remove OKA Mosquito Repellent Stick from box. Ignite tip until it flames and invert to further ignite body of the Stick. When this occurs, blow out flame. It will now burn without flame and create a smoke to repel mosquitoes. Place bottom of stick end into ground.

Place OKA Mosquito Repellent Sticks about every 10-12 feet apart. To extinguish, gently knock off glowing tip and extinguish tip into dirt or sand.

NOTE: If cracks appear in body of stick, this is normal and in no way impedes its effectiveness.

STORAGE: Store in a dry place (preferably locked) inaccessible to children and pets and away from sources of heat or ignition. DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty box. Used Sticks: Sweep ashes into trash. Unused Sticks: Wrap in newspaper and discard in trash.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS Hazards to Humans & Domestic Animals

CAUTION: Avoid prolonged inhalation or contact with skin. Avoid contact with eyes or clothing. Do not touch lit end of stick. Do not use indoors. Wash hands after use and before eating or smoking.
