- b. Include the EPA Establishment Number of your packaging facility on the label in the vicinity of the EPA Registration Number.
- c. Delete the term FOOD PROCESSING PLANTS from the list of acceptable use sites.
- d. Revise the label such that the STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT appears directly below the PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS section of the product label.
- e. The term INERT INGREDIENT should be pluralized to read as INERT INGREDIENTS.
- f. Revise the guarantee statement "STI will not be held responsible for loss of..." to read as follows: STI will not be responsible for loss of effectiveness when product is used in a manner inconsistent with the label directions.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

CUT END OF CAULK TUBE AND INSERT INTO CAULK-GUN. To control large and small roaches, cockroaches, ants, waterbugs, and silverfish, Apply ROACH MASTER onto baseboard behind refrigerator, stove, dishwasher, washing machines, dryers, tubs, and into openings around drains, water pipes and electrical conduits, and in cracks and crevices along baseboards and corners of cabinets, cupboards, and closets. Open drawers and cabinets, bedroom dressers and chests of drawers, and apply ROACH MASTER into vertical and horizontal crevices. Lift ceiling tiles and squirt ROACH MASTER into cockroach breeding beds. Any visible caulk after application must be wiped up with rag

and then properly disposed of. Apply only in areas inaccessible to children and pets. Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs. DIRECTIONS FOR APPLYING IN NEW CONSTRUCTION: CONTROL COCKROACHES. When treating large areas, such as inside walls, soffit, subcabinet and attic voids, draw ROACH MASTER caulk bead and spread generously.

Apply ROACH MASTER directly into cracks and crevices using a standard caulk-gun. In new construction, apply ROACH MASTER after rough framing is completed and before drywall or other stud cover is put up. Apply ROACH MASTER in attics also. For application in existing buildings, see above directions. Care should be taken to avoid depositing the product onto exposed surfaces, introducing the material into the air. Avoid contamination of feed or food processing surfaces.

APPLICATION OF THIS PRODUCT IN THE FOOD AREAS OF FOOD HANDLING ESTABLISHMENTS, OTHER THAN AS A CRACK AND CREVICE TREATMENT, ARE NOT PERMITTED.

SERVING AREAS- Facilities where prepared foods are served, such as dining rooms, but excluding areas where food may be prepared or held. Apply as a spot treatment of selective surfaces such as baseboards, under electrical conduits, and in cracks and crevices. Avoid treating surfaces likely to be contacted by food. NON-FOOD AREAS-Include garbage rooms, lavatories, floor drains (to sewer entries and vestibules), closets, rooms, machine rooms, garages, rooms with boilers, mop closets and storage (after canning or bottling), baseboard areas, around water pipes, surfaces behind and beneath sinks, lockers, tables, pallets and any other areas where these disease ridden cockroaches may hide or enter your dwelling place.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT: Immediately contact Poison Control Center or Physician if eye contact occurs. Flush eyes with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL: Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. STORAGE: Store in a dry cool room. Do not store where children or animals may gain access. DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container in several layers of newspaper and put in trash collection.
