DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Use Restrictions: Children and pets should not be in treatment area until after application is completed. Do not treat pets with this product. Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuff. Avoid contamination of ornamental plants.

Application Directions

Carpets: Be sure to vacate entire area of children, infants and pets before application. Using the applicator container, apply Flealess to dry surfaces only. Apply directly to carpets where pets frequently traffic or sleep at the rate of one pound per 100 square feet (31.5 mg/sq. in). In other areas, you may apply at the rate of one pound per 600 sq. feet (5.25 mg/sq. in). Work powder deeply into fibers and mat with a broom or rug rake. Any powder visible after application **MUST** be brushed into carpet fibers or removed. See Precautionary Statements on left panel.

Upholstery: Remove loose cushions. Apply along creases and into corners and furniture wells. Do not apply product to exposed fabric. Any product visible after application **MUST** be removed. See Precautionary Statements on left panel.
