

Subject: Submission of amendment in accordance with PR Notice 2000-3. "First Aid Statements on Pesticide Product Labels"
Product Name: Bengal Wasp & Hornet Killer 93
Registration No. 68543-8
Submission Date: June 5, 2000

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), is acceptable subject to the comments listed below.

- The Environmental Hazards statement modifications are not addressed in PR Notice 2000-3. This required language for the Environmental Hazards is outlined as part of the Agency's Label Review Manual, and can be located at the following internet address: <http://www.epa.gov/oppfead1/labeling/lrm/chap-09.htm>. In accordance with the Label Review Manual guidelines, you should retain the following Environmental Hazards language. **"This pesticide is toxic to fish and aquatic invertebrates." "Do not apply directly to water."** within the Environmental Hazards section. If your product is packaged or used in a container other than a pressurized aerosol, you must also include the statement: **"Cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes must be done in a manner that avoids contamination of bodies of water or wetlands."** You may submit acceptable information (acute environmental toxicity studies performed on the technical grade of each the active ingredients in the formulation) to demonstrate that the relevant toxicology triggers are not met as outlined in the Label Review manual.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Spray in upright position. Inverting can while spraying may lower can pressure and cause reduced spray distance and performance.

FOR CONTROL OF WASPS AND HORNETS: It is preferable to apply this product in the evening after all the insects have returned to the nest. Aim valve opening at the nest and depress button, continuing to spray until the nest is soaked with the spray. Repeat as necessary.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in a cool dry area away from heat or open flame.

DISPOSAL: Replace cap and discard container in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture.

**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS
HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS**

CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed. Contains petroleum distillate. Do not induce vomiting because of aspiration pneumonia hazard. Do not breathe vapors or spray mist. Causes slight eye irritation. Do not get in eyes. Avoid contact with skin and clothing. Wash contaminated skin promptly with soap and warm water. Avoid contamination of food and feedstuffs.

If in eyes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.
If on skin or clothing	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes.
If inhaled	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible.
