In accordance with the Label Review Manual guidelines, you should retain the following Environmental Hazards language. "This pesticide is toxic to fish and aquatic invertebrates." "Do not apply directly to water." within the Environmental Hazards section. If your product is packaged or used in a container other than a pressurized aerosol, you must also include the statement: "Cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes must be done in a manner that avoids contamination of bodies of water or wetlands." You may submit acceptable information (acute environmental toxicity studies performed on the technical grade of each the active ingredients in the formulation) to demonstrate that the relevant toxicology triggers are not met as outlined in the Label Review manual.



FOR CONTROL OF WASPS AND HORNETS: It is preferable to apply this product in the evening after all the insects have returned to the nest. Aim valve opening at the nest and depress button, continuing to spray until the nest is soaked with the spray. Repeat as necessary.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in a cool dry area away from heat or open flame. DISPOSAL: Replace cap and discard container in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture.
