

I am submitting an application to add pests (Asian Lady Beetles and Stink Bugs) by notification to the label of Bengal Roach & Ant Spray IV, EPA Reg. No. 68543-17.

A copy of the revised label is enclosed and the additional insect names are underlined and in italics, and can be found in the section with the heading "For Spot Treatment".

Also enclosed is a stamped self-addressed postcard to be signed and returned to acknowledge receipt of this notification.

This notification is consistent with the provisions of PR Notice 98-10 and EPA regulations at 40 CFR 152.46, and no other changes have been made to the labeling or the confidential statement of formula of this product. I understand that it is a violation of 18 U.S.C. Sec. 1001 to willfully make any false statement to EPA. I further understand that if this notification is not consistent with the terms of PR Notice 98-10 and 40 CFR 152.46, this product may be in violation of FIFRA and I may be subject to enforcement action and penalties under sections 12 and 14 of FIFRA.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

SHAKE:WELL BEFORE USING

General: Use this spray as a spot or crack and crevice treatment to control cockroaches, fleas, silverfish, ticks, waterbugs, and other insects disted below. Apply this product

only as a coarse spray or crack and crevice treatment to a localized areas where pests are found or may occur. Spray surfaces until wet. Repeat as needed.

FOR SPOT TREATMENT:

To kill Ants, Asian Lady Beetles, Black Widow Spiders, Carpet Beetles, Centipedes, Cigarette Beetles, Cockroaches, Confused Flour Beetles, Crickets, Indian Meal Moths, Rice Weevils, Sawtoothed Grain Beetles, Scorpions, Silverfish, Sowbugs, Stink Bugs and Spiders: Spray areas where these insects are found or may hide, including dark corners of rooms and closets; cracks and crevices in walls; along baseboards and door and window frames; behind and beneath sinks, stoves, refrigerators, and cabinets; and around garbage cans, plumbing and other utility installations. Pests driven out of hiding places should be sprayed directly. For ants, spray ant trails and around doors and windows, and wherever else these pests may find entrance. Repeat as necessary. For control of Black Carpet Beetles, spray along baseboards and edges of carpeting, under carpeting, rugs, and furniture and wherever these insects are seen or suspected.

To Kill Brown Dog Ticks and Fleas: Thoroughly apply as a spot treatment to infested areas such as pet beds and resting quarters, nearby cracks and crevices, along and behind baseboards, window and door frames, and localized areas of floor coverings where these pests may be present. Pet's old bedding should be removed and replaced with clean fresh bedding after treatment. DO NOT SPRAY PETS WITH THIS PRODUCT. Pets should be treated with a registered flea and tick control product before reentering treated areas.

FOR CRACK AND CREVICE TREATMENT:

To kill Ants, Black Widow Spiders, Brown Dog Ticks, Carpet Beetles, Cockroaches, Crickets, Fleas, Scorpions, Silverfish, Sowbugs, and Spiders: Apply spray in small amounts directly into cracks and crevices. Equipment capable of delivering a pin stream should be used in points between different elements of construction, between equipment and floors, openings leading into voids and hollow spaces in walls, equipment legs and bases where these insects hide.

Cash

Care should be taken to avoid depositing the product onto exposed surfaces or introducing the material into the air. Avoid contamination of food or food handling surfaces.

Flies and Mosquitoes: Use only outdoors as an aid in reducing annoyance from these insects. Spray outside surfaces of window and door frames as well as other areas where these pests may enter the home. Also spray dark corners and localized resting areas (such as under eaves) or porches, patios, and garages where these insects may congregate. Flies and mosquitoes coming to rest on treated surfaces will be killed. Repeat treatment when necessary.

FIRST AID

IF SWALLOWED:

- Call poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice.
- Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow.
- Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by the poison control center or doctor.
- Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING:

- Take off contaminated clothing.
- Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15 20 minutes.
- Call a physician or poison control center for treatment advice.

Have the product container or label with you when calling a poison control center or doctor, or going for treatment.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Avoid contact with eyes, skin or clothing. Prolonged or frequently repeated skin contact may cause allergic reaction in some individuals. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Obtain medical attention if irritation persists. Avoid contamination of food and feedstuffs.

Do not use in food/feed areas of food/feed handling establishments, restaurants or other areas where food/feed is commercially prepared or processed. In the home, all food processing surfaces and usensils should be covered during
