Pests driven out of hiding places should be sprayed directly. For ants, spray ant trails and around doors and windows, and wherever else these pests may find entrance. For control of Black Carpet Beetles, spray along baseboards and edges of carpeting, under carpeting, rugs, and furniture and wherever these insects are seen or suspected. Each spot treatment should be no larger than 2 ft. x 2 ft.

To Kill Brown Dog Ticks and Fleas: Thoroughly apply as a spot treatment to infested areas such as pet beds and resting quarters, nearby cracks and crevices, along and behind baseboards, window and door frames, and localized areas of floor and floor coverings where these pests may be present. Pets should be treated with a registered flea and tick control product prior to reentering treated areas.
