The Agency, in accordance with the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, has completed reviewing all the information submitted with your application to support the Registration Review of the above referenced product in connection with the Permethrin Interim Decision, and has concluded that your submission is acceptable. The label referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA, as amended, is acceptable.

Should you wish to add/retain a reference to the company's website on your label, then please be aware that the website becomes labeling under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act and is subject to review by the Agency. If the website is false or misleading, the product would be misbranded and unlawful to sell or distribute under FIFRA section 12(a)(1)(E). 40 CFR 156.10(a)(5) list examples of statements EPA may consider false or misleading. In addition, regardless of whether a website is referenced on your product's label, claims made on the website may not substantially differ from those claims approved through the registration process. Therefore, should the Agency find or if it is brought to our attention that a website contains false or misleading statements or claims substantially differing from the EPA approved registration, the website will be referred to the EPA's Office of Enforcement and Compliance Assurance.

A stamped copy of your labeling is enclosed for your records. This labeling supersedes all previously accepted labeling and must be used at your next label printing. You must submit one copy of the final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment with the new labeling. In accordance with 40 CFR 152.130(c), you may distribute or sell this product under the previously approved labeling for 12 months from the date of this letter. After 12 months, you may only distribute or sell this product if it bears this new revised labeling or subsequently approved labeling. "To distribute or sell" is defined under FIFRA section 2(gg) and its implementing regulation at 40 CFR 152.3.

Bengal Yard and Patio Spray is an outdoor product for use in backyards, patios, decks, porches and other areas where listed flying insects are a problem. When sprayed on surfaces outdoors, Bengal Yard and Patio Spray residually kills listed flying insects that land on treated surfaces for 24 hours.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. For outdoor use only.

All outdoor spray applications must be limited to spot or crack-and-crevice treatments only, except for the following permitted uses: 1. Application to pervious surfaces such as soil, lawn, turf, and other vegetation; 2. Perimeter band treatments of 7 feet wide or less from the base of a man-made structure to pervious surfaces (e.g., soil, mulch, or lawn); 3. Applications to underside of eaves, soffits, doors, or windows permanently protected from rainfall by a covering, overhang, awning, or other structure; 4. Applications around potential exterior pest entry points into man-made structures such as doorways and windows, when limited to a band not to exceed one inch; 5. Applications to vertical surfaces (such as the side of a man-made structure) directly above impervious surfaces (e.g., driveways, sidewalks, etc.), up to 2 feet above ground level; 6. Applications to vertical surfaces directly above pervious surfaces, such as soil, lawn, turf, mulch or other vegetation) only if the pervious surface does not drain into ditches, storm drains, gutters, or surface waters.

For soil or foliar applications, do not apply within 25 feet of lakes, reservoirs, rivers, permanent streams, marshes or natural ponds, estuaries and commercial fish farm ponds.

Do not apply the product into fish pools, ponds, streams, or lakes. Do not apply directly to sewers or storm drains, or to any area like a drain or gutter where drainage to sewers, storm drains, water bodies, or aquatic habitat can occur.

Do not allow the product to enter any drain during or after application.

Do not apply directly to impervious horizontal surfaces such as sidewalks, driveways, and patios except as a spot or crack-and-crevice treatment.

Do not apply or irrigate to the point of runoff.

Spot treatments must not exceed two square feet in size (for example, 2 ft. by 1 ft. or 4 ft. by 0.5 ft.). Do not make applications during rain. Avoid making applications when rainfall is expected before the product has sufficient time to dry (minimum 4 hours).

Rainfall within 24 hours after application may cause unintended runoff of pesticide application. Do not apply when the wind speed is greater than 15 mph. Treat surfaces to ensure thorough coverage but avoid runoff. To treat insects harbored in voids and cracks-and-crevices, applications must be made in such a manner to limit dripping and avoid runoff onto untreated structural surfaces and plants.

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING

OUTDOOR PESTS

FLYING INSECTS: To kill flies, mosquitoes, sand flies, gnats, small flying moths: For residual control of flying insects: treat screens, around window and door frames, porches, surfaces around light fixtures, ornamental bushes, in garages and other surfaces where flying insects light or gather. Hold can 2 to 3 feet from the surface to be treated and spray to slightly moisten the surface. Bengal Yard and Patio Spray will not damage plants and bushes or finished surfaces on the exterior of homes or buildings.

CRAWLING INSECTS:

To kill cockroaches, ants, spiders, crickets, scorpions, sowbugs, centipedes, stink bugs, brown marmorated stink bugs (bmsb), Asian lady beetles, and boxelder bugs: Contact as many insects as possible with the spray. Do not enter or allow others to enter until sprays have dried. For residual control of crawling insects on outdoor surfaces, spray where pests are active or where they may enter buildings. Special attention should be paid to cracks and crevices, window and door frames, eaves, porches, patios and garages. Hold can 2 to 3 feet from the surface to be treated and spray to slightly moisten surface but not to the point of runoff. **SPIDERS:** Treat surfaces where spider webs are seen to kill spiders and prevent other spiders from building webs for up to 30 days. Direct exposure to rainfall reduces this products effectiveness.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARD TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION. Causes moderate eye irritation. Avoid contact with skin, eyes, or clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking, chewing gum, or using tobacco.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Contents under pressure. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Do not use this product in or on electrical equipment due to the possibility of shock hazard. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting. Never leave container in parked or unattended vehicles.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This pesticide is extremely toxic to aquatic organisms, including fish and invertebrates. Do not apply directly to or near water. Drift and runoff may be hazardous to fish in water adjacent to treated areas. Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment, washwater, or rinsate.
