DIRECTIONS FOR USE

This product is non-staining to most home siding and asphalt shingles depending on the condition and cleanliness. However, you should test it in an inconspicuous area for compatibility before using on these surfaces.

TO KILL WASPS, HORNETS, BEES AND YELLOW JACKETS

1. Apply early morning or late evening when the most insects are on the nest.
2. Spray from a safe distance with the wind at your back to avoid spray drift. Do not stand directly under the nest.
3. Shake can well before use. Aim nozzle at the nest and push button to spray.
4. Soak the nest with the spray contacting as many insects as possible.
5. Wait 24 hours before removing nest so returning insects will be killed.
