- 2. Make the following change(s) to the label:
 - a. Change the product registration number to "EPA Reg. No. 68543-37"
 - b. Make the following label revision(s):

General Comment(s):

- 1. Delete all text throughout the proposed label marked with "strike-through."
- 2. Within the product name, replace the word "PYRETHRIN" with the word "PYRETHRINS," so that it reads "BENGAL PYRETHRINS ROACH SPRAY."
- 3. Claims against public health pests must be removed from the product label. Specifically, since this application was submitted after the pyrethrins DCI was issued; the cite-all method of data support cannot be used for public health pests. In order to support these claims, specific efficacy (product performance) data must be submitted or cited.

Optional Marketing Claims comment(s):

- 4. Delete the 3rd optional marketing claim, since this is an implied safety claim.
- 5. Delete the 5th and 6th optional marketing claims, since these claims are not supported by any product performance (flushing) data.
- 6. Delete the 9th optional marketing claim, since it is similar to the revised 8th optional marketing claim.

Directions for Use section comment(s):

- 7. Within the 4th bulleted statement of the "USE RESTRICTIONS AND PRECAUTIONS" subsection, insert the word "directly" immediately preceding the word "on."
- 8. Delete the subsection that starts with "FOR USE IN THE FOLLOWING RESIDENTIAL AREAS (HOMES, DOG HOUSES, ANUMAL QUARTERS, ..." as discussed in detail in item #3 above.
- 9. Within the subsection heading that starts with "[FOR USE IN HOME GREENHOUSES TO KILLS EXPOSED...," replace the word "KILLS" with the word "KILL."

- 10. Please note that the "1-800-222-1222" telephone number listed on the proposed label must be available twenty-four (24) hours per day, seven (7) days per week for answering and responding to any medical emergencies or health concerns.
- 3. You must submit two (2) copies of the revised final printed labeling, incorporating the above changes, before releasing the product for shipment. If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with section 6(e) of FIFRA. Your release for shipment of the product bearing amended labeling constitutes accepting of these conditions.

Should you wish to add/retain a reference to the company's website on your label, please be aware that the website becomes labeling under FIFRA and is subject to review by the Agency. If the website is false or misleading, the product would be misbranded and unlawful to sell or distribute under section 12(a)(1)(E) of FIFRA. 40 CFR §156.10(a)(5) lists examples of statements EPA may consider false or misleading. In addition, regardless of whether a website is referenced on your product's label, claims made on the website may not be substantially differ from those claims approved through the registration process.
