The Agency, in accordance with the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, has completed reviewing all the information submitted with your application to support the Registration Review of the above referenced product in connection with the Permethrin Interim Decision, and has concluded that your submission is acceptable. The label referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA, as amended, is acceptable.

Should you wish to add/retain a reference to the company's website on your label, then please be aware that the website becomes labeling under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act and is subject to review by the Agency. If the website is false or misleading, the product would be misbranded and unlawful to sell or distribute under FIFRA section 12(a)(1)(E). 40 CFR 156.10(a)(5) list examples of statements EPA may consider false or misleading. In addition, regardless of whether a website is referenced on your product's label, claims made on the website may not substantially differ from those claims approved through the registration process. Therefore, should the Agency find or if it is brought to our attention that a website contains false or misleading statements or claims substantially differing from the EPA approved registration, the website will be referred to the EPA's Office of Enforcement and Compliance Assurance.

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A stamped copy of your labeling is enclosed for your records. This labeling supersedes all previously accepted labeling and must be used at your next label printing. You must submit one copy of the final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment with the new labeling. In accordance with 40 CFR 152.130(c), you may distribute or sell this product under the previously approved labeling for 12 months from the date of this letter. After 12 months, you may only distribute or sell this product if it bears this new revised labeling or subsequently approved labeling. "To distribute or sell" is defined under FIFRA section 2(gg) and its implementing regulation at 40 CFR 152.3.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. For outdoor use only.

All outdoor spray applications must be limited to spot or crack-and-crevice treatments only, except for the following permitted uses:

- 1. Application to pervious surfaces such as soil, lawn, turf, and other vegetation;
- 2. Applications to underside of eaves, soffits, doors, or windows permanently protected from rainfall by a covering, overhang, awning, or other structure;
- 3. Applications around potential exterior pest entry points into man-made structures such as doorways and windows, when limited to a band not to exceed one inch;
- 4. Applications to vertical surfaces (such as the side of a man-made structure) directly above impervious surfaces (e.g., driveways, sidewalks, etc.), up to 2 feet above ground level;
- 5. Applications to vertical surfaces directly above pervious surfaces, such as soil, lawn, turf, mulch or other vegetation) only if the pervious surface does not drain into ditches, storm drains, gutters, or surface waters.

For soil or foliar applications, do not apply within 25 feet of lakes, reservoirs, rivers, permanent streams, marshes or natural ponds, estuaries and commercial fish farm ponds.

Spot treatments must not exceed two square feet in size (for example, 2ft. by 1 ft or 4 ft. by 0.5 ft.). Do not spray the product into fish pools, ponds, streams, or lakes. Do not apply directly to sewers or storm drains, or to any area like a drain or gutter where drainage to sewers, storm drains, water bodies, or aquatic habitat can occur. Do not allow the product to enter any drain during or after application. Do not apply directly to impervious horizontal surfaces such as sidewalks, driveways, and patios except as a spot or crack-and-crevice treatment. Do not apply or irrigate to the point of runoff. Do not make applications during rain. Avoid making applications when rainfall is expected before the product has sufficient time to dry (minimum 4 hours). Rainfall within 24 hours after application may cause unintended runoff of pesticide application. Treat surfaces to ensure thorough coverage but avoid runoff. To treat insects harbored in voids and cracks-and-crevices, applications must be made in such a manner to limit dripping and avoid runoff onto untreated structural surfaces and plants.

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING.

OUTDOORS: This type of application is not a substitute for soil treatment, mechanical alterations or fumigation to control extensive infestations of termites and wood-destroying insects.

FOR CARPENTER BEES: [Insert extension tube into spray button.] Point nozzle at nest entrance and spray from a safe distance with the wind at your back to avoid spray drift. Apply early morning or late evening when the insects are least active. Do not stand directly under the nest entrance. Spray holes and other openings until surfaces are thoroughly wet, contacting as many carpenter bees as possible. Wait 24 hours so returning insects will be killed, then repair damaged wood surfaces as necessary.

KILLS: Ants (foraging Carpenter, Fire and Harvester ants; excluding Pharaoh ants), Wood-Boring Beetles (powderpost and deathwatch), Ground Nesting Yellowjackets and Termites* [exposed drywood, dampwood & subterranean]. Aim spray at nest openings in ground, bushes, and in cracks and crevices of wood structures which may harbor nests, saturating nest openings and contacting as many insects as possible.

*For spot treatment and localized kill only.

To control Boxelder Bugs, Flies, Mosquitoes, Scorpions, Silverfish, Sowbugs, and Spiders; treat surface areas where insects are commonly found, such as window and door frames, around pipes, cracks and crevices, and around garbage containers. Spray surfaces until thoroughly wet, contacting as many insects as possible.

TO KILL WASPS, HORNETS, AND YELLOW JACKETS

- 1. Apply early morning or late evening when the most insects are on the nest.
- 2. Spray from a safe distance with the wind at your back to avoid spray drift. Do not stand directly under the nest.
- 3. Shake can well before use. Aim nozzle at the nest and push button to spray.
- 4. Soak the nest with the spray contacting as many insects as possible.
- 5. Wait 24 hours before removing nest so returning insects will be killed.
