On the basis of information furnished by the registrant, the above named pesticide is hereby registered/reregistered under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended. In order to protect health and the environment, the Administrator, on her/his motion, may at any time suspend or cancel the registration of a pesticide in accordance with the Act. 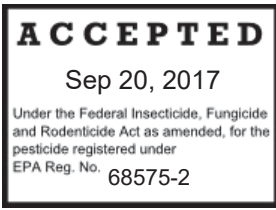

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. PALENE 710 C is for use on aluminum automobile evaporator cores to inhibit mold and mildew growth and to decrease the surface tension of water. This product is to be mixed only on-site with PALENE 710 A and Palene 710 B and is to be used to coat final product only. To prepare the PALENE bath for process treatment use 4 gallons of PALENE 710 C with every 100 gallons of PALENE 710 A (Polymer/Resin) and 7 gallons of PALENE 710 B (Chrome Solution). The evaporator core is then fully dipped in the bath for a minimum of 10 seconds and is then dried and cured in the dry-off oven at 280° F for 30 minutes.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL Do not contaminate wood, water, or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited. **STORAGE** Protect from frost. Store between 40°F - 100°F. Moisture and sunlight will not affect the product.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Pesticide wastes are acutely hazardous. Improper disposal of excess pesticide spray mixture or rinsate is a violation of Federal law. If these waters cannot be disposed of by use according to label instructions, contact your State Pesticide or Environmental Control Agency or the Hazardous Waste representative at the nearest EPA Regional Office for guidance. **CONTAINER DISPOSAL:** Triple rinse (or equivalent).
