3. Revise the Precautionary Statement to read:



DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

USE RESTRICTIONS

For Control of Cockroaches, ants and silverfish, in homes, restaurants, markets, schools, warehouses, factories, offices, hotels, motels, hospitals, nursing homes, garages, grocery stores, apartment buildings, new construction, industrial plants, theaters, ships, boats, trains, trucks, yachts, camps, mobile homes, buses, zoos, kennels, military bases, libraries, utilities and sewers.

Apply only in areas inaccessible to children and pets. Do not use in edible product areas of food handling establishments, restaurants or other areas while food is exposed. Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuff.

APPLICATION DIRECTIONS

Apply paste liberally, **DO NOT SPREAD**. Apply paste material under and behind refrigerator, stove, sink, washing machine and dryer, into openings around drains, water pipes and electrical conduits, and in cracks and crevices along baseboard and corners of cabinets, cupboards and closets. Remove all lower drawers in kitchen and bathroom cabinets, bedroom dressers and chests of drawers. Apply paste liberally in drawer wells. Any paste visible after application must be scrapped into cracks and crevices or removed. Reapply paste as necessary. May also be used in treating large areas, such as wall voids, soffit and subcabinet voids in new and existing construction.
