

Bathe pet with a quality cleaning shampoo. Dilute 4 ounces of Dip Concentrate with 1 gallon of water. Dip animal into solution, making sure hair is thoroughly wet to the skin. The area around the ears should be sponged thoroughly. Avoid contact of material with eyes and mouth of animal. Do not rinse off. Do not repeat treatment for one week.

Consult a veterinarian before using this product on debilitated, aged, pregnant or nursing animals, or animals on medication.
