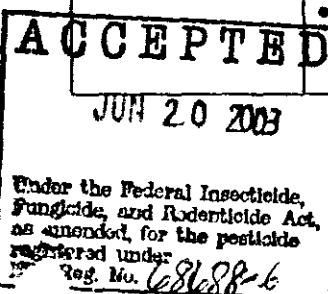
HUMAN: Harmful if swallowed or inhaled.

spray on tips of fingers and rub into coat. Do  
not treat kittens or puppies less than 12 weeks  
of age. Sensitivities may occur after using  
ANY pesticide product for pets. If signs of  
sensitivity occur, bathe your pet with mild soap  
and rinse with large amounts of water. If signs  
continue, consult a veterinarian immediately.

## FIRST AID

### IF SWALLOWED:

- Call poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice.
- Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow.
- Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by the poison control center or doctor.
- Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.



## FIRST AID (Cont'd)

### IF INHALED:

- Move person to fresh air.
- If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible.
- Call a poison control center or doctor for further treatment advice.

### IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING:

- Take off contaminated clothing.
- Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes.
- Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

### IF IN EYES:

- Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes.
- Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye.
- Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

#### **DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

#### **SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING HOLD BOTTLE IN UPRIGHT POSITION WHEN SPRAYING**

**CATS and DOGS:** Cover animal's eyes with hands and with a firm stroke to get a proper spray mist, spray head, ears and chest until damp. With fingertips, rub into face around mouth, nose and eyes. Then spray neck, middle and hind quarters, finishing legs last. For best penetration of spray to the skin, direct spray against the natural lay of the hair. On long haired dogs, rub your hand against the lay of the hair spraying the ruffled hair directly behind the hand. Make sure spray thoroughly wets ticks. Do not repeat treatment for one week.

**PUPPIES and KITTENS:** Treat same as cats and dogs except nursing puppies and kittens. Spray only along back or on your fingertips and rub in with your fingertips.

**PET'S SLEEPING QUARTERS:** Spray around baseboards, windows, door frames, wall cracks and local area of floors. If mosquitoes, gnats or flies are present, spray lightly into the air. Repeat as needed. The pet's bedding should be sprayed, making sure the area beneath the bedding is sprayed too. After the spray has dried, remove old bedding and replace with fresh bedding. Treat pets with a registered Flea and Tick Control product before allowing them to enter treated area.

**HORSES:** To control **stable flies, horse flies, deer flies and face flies**, apply to face, legs, flanks, top line and other body areas commonly attacked by these flies. Repeat as necessary.

Consult a veterinarian before using this

product on debilitated, aged, pregnant or nursing animals, or animals on medication.

#### **FOR USE AS A WIPE**

**DOGS & CATS:** Cover pet's eyes with hand. Wipe head, ears and chest until damp. Rub into face around mouth, nose and eyes, avoiding direct contact with the eyes. For best penetration to the skin, direct wipe against the normal lay of the hair. Make sure wipe thoroughly wets ticks. For nursing puppies and kittens, rub only along back of animal. Do not reapply product for 3 days.

**HORSES & FOALS:** Avoid treatment of nursing foals. First, brush animal to remove excess dirt and dust. Rub wipe into face around mouth, nose, eyes, ears and areas where flies are often seen. Then wipe the neck, legs, and shoulders and shanks. Avoid using an excessive amount and do not wet skin. After application, brush thoroughly to bring out a bright sheen on the coat. Repeat only as necessary.

#### **STORAGE AND DISPOSAL**

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

**STORAGE:** Store in a cool, dry place away from heat or open flame.

**DISPOSAL:** **If empty:** Do not reuse this container. Place in trash or offer for recycling if available. **If partly filled:** Call your local solid waste agency or 1-800-CLEANUP for disposal instructions. Never place unused product down any indoor or outdoor drain.
