FOR USE ON HORSES AND PONIES

KILLS AND REPELS: Horse flies, Stable flies, Face flies, Horn flies, Deer flies, Houseflies, Mosquitoes and Gnats.

KILLS: Fleas, Lice, and Ticks.

Effective for use as a wipe-on or as a spray on the animal, as well as a space spray in Horse barns, Stables, or Tack rooms.

This concentrate should be diluted with water or oil.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is toxic to fish. Keep out of lakes, streams or ponds. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes. Apply this product only as specified on the label

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

AVOID CONTACT OF PRODUCT WITH EYES OR NOSTRILS

ON HORSES AND PONIES: Brush the animal thoroughly to remove loose dirt and dust. Prepare the appropriate dilution in the amount required for immediate use (about one quart per horse). Diluted product should be used within 24 hours.

TO KILL AND REPEL HOUSEFLIES, HORN FLIES, GNATS AND MOSQUITOES: Dilute 1 part concentrate with 14 parts water.

TO KILL AND REPEL HORSE FLIES, STABLE FLIES, DEER FLIES AND FACE FLIES: Dilute 1 part concentrate with 9 parts water. Moisten (do not soak) a folded 12" square piece of Turkish toweling with the dilution. Rub against, then with hair growth. Give special attention to facial areas, neck, legs, shoulders, and shanks where the flies are most often seen. Apply thoroughly to moisten hair. If desired the sheen of the coat may be enhanced by light brushing following application. For best results apply daily.

TO KILL FLEAS AND LICE: Using a dilution of 1 part concentrate to 49 parts water. Apply enough spray to thoroughly wet the skin of the animal. To help in prevention of reinfestation, thoroughly spray premises and sleeping quarters paying particular attention to cracks and crevices. Repeat application as necessary.

TO KILL ATTACHED TICKS: Saturate a cloth with this concentrate and daub directly on ticks.

IN HORSE BARN, STABLE AND TACK ROOMS: To control flies, mosquitoes, and gnats dilute at a rate of 1 part concentrate to 24 parts water or oil and apply as a fog or fine mist directing spray toward the ceiling and upper corners until the area is filled with mist using about 2 ounces per 1000 cubic feet of space. For best results close doors and windows before spraying and keep them closed for ten to fifteen minutes. Vacate the area

and ventilate before reoccupying. Apply as necessary to give continued protection.

FOR USE AS A WATER SPRAY

1-9 Dilution: Mix 1 quart of concentrate with 9 parts water to make 2½ gallons spray. Stir before using. Apply at the rate of 1 pint to 1 quart of dilute spray per animal depending on the size of the animal. This dilution will kill horse flies, stable flies, houseflies, horn flies, mosquitoes, and gnats on the animal at the time of application. Apply as necessary to give continued protection.

1-14 Dilution: Mix 1 quart of concentrate with 14 quarts of water to make 3¼ gallons of spray. Stir before using. Apply at the rate of 1 pint to 1 quart per animal depending on the size of the animal. This dilution will kill horn flies, mosquitoes and gnats on the animal at the time of application. Apply as necessary to give continued protection.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in a cool dry area inaccessible to children and away from heat or open flame.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse this container. Wrap and put in trash.
