DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product

Thoroughly soak animal with warm water taking
2-3 minutes to wet hair. Do not apply shampoo
around eyes. Apply shampoo on head and ears,

then lather; repeat procedure with neck, chest, middle and hind quarter, finishing legs last. Let animal stand 10 minutes (this is an important part of the grooming procedure), then rinse animal thoroughly. In extremely dirty, or scaly animals, the above procedure may be repeated. Pet bedding and quarters should be treated simultaneously with an approved product. Consult a veterinarian before using this product on debilitated, aged, pregnant or nursing animals, or animals on medication. Do not reapply product for one week.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL
