The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below:

1. Revise the "IF INHALED" Statement of Practical Treatment to read as follows:

IF INHALED: Remove victim to fresh air. Get medical attention.
2. Revise the "IF IN EYES" Statement of Practical Treatment to read as follows:

"Hold eyelids open and flush with a steady, gentle stream of water for 15 minutes. Get medical attention."
3. Revise the front panel statement "(not for slaughter)" to ensure that it applies to both Horses and Foals.
4. Revise the Physical or Chemical Hazards Statement to read as follows:

"Flammable. Keep away from heat and open flame. Do not use this product in or on electrical equipment due to the possibility of shock hazard."
5. Delete the statement "Do not use this product in or on electrical equipment due to the possibility of shock hazard." from the Directions for Use. You will have moved this information to the Physical or Chemical Hazards statement.

WARNING

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

HUMANS: Causes eye and skin irritation. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Harmful if swallowed or inhaled. Avoid breathing mist. Keep out of eyes. Avoid contamination of food. Wash hands with soap and water after using.

ANIMALS: Avoid treatment of foals, nursing kittens and puppies under six weeks old. If treatment is necessary, spray on tips of fingers and rub coat.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is toxic to fish. Keep out of lakes, streams, ponds, tidal marshes and estuaries. Do not apply where runoff is likely to occur.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Flammable. Keep away from heat and open flame.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF IN EYES: Flush with plenty of water. Get medical attention.

IF ON SKIN: Wash with plenty of soap and water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

IF SWALLOWED: Drink promptly a large quantity of milk, egg whites, gelatin solution, or if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol.

IF INHALED: Remove person to fresh air.

DIRECTIONS

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

USE ONLY IN WELL VENTILATED AREA

CATS AND DOGS: Cover animals eyes with hands. With a firm stroke to get a proper spray mist, spray head, ears and chest until damp. With fingertips, rub into face around mouth, nose and eyes. Then spray neck, middle and hind quarters, finishing legs last. For best penetration of spray to the skin, direct spray against the natural lay of the hair. On long haired dogs, rub your hand against the lay of the hair, spraying the ruffled hair directly behind the hand. Make sure spray thoroughly wets ticks. Repeat treatment as needed.

PUPPIES AND KITTENS: Treat same as cats and dogs except nursing puppies and kittens. Spray only along back or on your fingertips and rub in.

PET'S SLEEPING QUARTERS: Spray around baseboards, windows, door frames, wall cracks and local areas of floors. If mosquitoes, gnats or flies are present, spray lightly into the air. Repeat as needed. The pets bedding should be sprayed, making sure the area beneath the bedding is sprayed. After spray has dried, remove old bedding and replace with fresh bedding. Treat pets with one of our registered Flea & Tick control products before allowing them to enter treated area.

HORSES (not for slaughter): Use full strength to control stable flies, horse flies, deer flies, face flies, gnats and mosquitoes. Apply to face, legs, flanks, top line and other body areas commonly attacked by these flies. Do not wet horses skin with excessive spray. After the application, brush thoroughly to bring out sheen on the coat. Repeat treatment as needed.

HOLD BOTTLE IN UPRIGHT POSITION WHEN SPRAYING

Do not use this product in or on electrical equipment due to the possibility of shock hazard.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Do not use or store near heat or open flame.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection.

DIRECTIONS FOR LIQUID DISPENSING COMB

KILLS FLEAS, TICKS, AND LICE ON CONTACT

The teeth of the comb are made of a porous nylon fiber much like a felt-tip pen. By simply combing your pet, the special flea and tick killing liquid saturates the comb's sturdy teeth and coats the animal's skin, fur and hair killing fleas and ticks on contact. This special liquid also contains agents to help keep your pet's coat smooth and shiny so your pet benefits from a healthy grooming, too. Comb is safe and gentle to be used daily.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Remove plug. Holding comb level, slowly add liquid through filling hole until wick is visibly damp. Do not overfill. Replace plug and allow a few minutes for teeth to become moistened. Comb pet thoroughly with a slow grooming motion. Be sure that both tips and sides of the teeth contact the skin, inner fur and hair. For pets with thick fur, groom by pushing back fur and combing around the roots. After use, wipe teeth gently with a dry paper towel or tissue. Store in a sealed plastic bag.
