taking 2-3 minutes to wet hair. Do not apply shampoo around eyes. Apply shampoo on head and ears, then lather; repeat procedure with neck, chest, middle and hind quarters, finishing legs last. Let animal stand 3-5 minutes (this is an important part of the grooming procedure.), then rinse animal thoroughly. In extremely dirty, or scaly animals, the above procedure may be repeated. May be used every 7-10 days.

Horses: Controls stable flies, horse flies, deer flies, face flies, gnats & mosquitoes. Follow above procedure. Do not use on puppies, kittens or foals under 12 weeks.

Consult a veterinarian before using this product on debilitated, aged, pregnant or nursing animals, or animals on medication.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in a cool area.

DISPOSAL: If empty: Do not reuse this container. Place in trash or offer for recycling if available. If partly empty: Call your local solid waste agency or 1-800-CLEANUP for disposal instructions. Never place unused product down any indoor or outdoor drain.
