Ear Mites live in the ear canal of the animal and cause a brownish, waxy debris to be formed.] [ Ear mites usually induce the formation of a dry, dark brown, waxy exudate with crusts in the ears of pets.] Ear mites may be detected by placing some of the waxy debris on a dark surface and carefully watching for the movement of tiny white specks away from the debris. Inflamed, watery or blocked ear canals indicate a more serious condition which requires the services of a veterinarian.*

### PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS CAUTION

**HUMANS:** Harmful if swallowed. Avoid breathing vapors. Avoid contact with eyes. In case of contact, immediately flush eyes with plenty of water. Obtain medical attention if irritation persists. If swallowed, do not induce vomiting. Wash hands with soap and water after using.

### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

#### To Kill Ear Mites

Clean ears to remove built-up wax and dirt. While firmly holding pet, fill ear canal with recommended number of drops in each ear. Massage base of ear to insure insecticidal action penetrates ear wax. Gently dry ear with a cotton ball, soft cloth, or cotton swab. This product may be applied daily for 7 to 10 days. Repeat treatment in two weeks if necessary.

#### [Alternate tube directions]

- (1) Remove one applicator tube from package and hold in an upright position.
- (2) Pull off cap. Turn the cap around and place on top of tube.
- (3) Simply press cap down to break the seal of tube and remove cap carefully.
- (4) Position the tip of the tube at the base of the pet's ear. Firmly hold pet and fill each ear canal with recommended number of drops.
- (5) Massage base of ear to insure insecticidal action penetrates ear wax.
- (6) Gently dry with a cotton ball, soft cloth or cotton swab.
- (7) After application simply invert the cap of the tube and snap back on the tube for easy closure.]

#### (Alternate Tube Directions)

- (1) Remove one applicator tube from package and hold in an upright position.
- (2) Hold bottom of tube with one hand. With

other hand, snap cap off.

- (3) Position the tip of the tube at the base of the pet's ear. Firmly hold pet and fill each ear canal with recommended number of drops.
- (4) Massage base of ear to insure insecticidal action penetrates ear wax.
- (5) Gently dry with a cotton ball, soft cloth or cotton swab.
- (6) After application simply invert the cap of the tube and snap back on the tube for easy closure.]

#### Body Weight

5 to 15 lbs. [ $< 15$  lbs.]

#### Dosage

4-5 drops/day/ear

If conditions for which this preparation is used persist or if an irritation develops, discontinue use and consult a veterinarian.

#### For Use With a Swabstick:

Open packet, remove swabstick. While firmly holding pet, fill ear with liquid from packet. Massage base of ear to insure that insecticidal action penetrates ear wax. Use swabstick to remove as much waxy exudate as possible from outer ear.

This product may be applied daily for 7 to 10 days. Repeat treatment in two weeks if necessary. Do not use on puppies or kittens less than 12 weeks. Consult a veterinarian before using this product on debilitated, aged, pregnant or nursing animals or animals on medications.

### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

**STORAGE:** Store in a cool, dry area away from heat or open flame.

**DISPOSAL:** If empty: Do not reuse this container. Place in trash or offer for recycling if available. If partly used: Call your local solid waste agency or 1-800-CLEANUP for disposal instructions. Never place unused product down any indoor or outdoor drain.
