Dear Mr. Washburn,

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. Five copies of the finished labeling must be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment.

1. The use deletion amendment for the technical product MGK264, removed any uses on dairy animals, dairy cattle, farm animals, cattle, beef cattle [meat animals], swine [meat animals] and barns. Therefore, the proposed label must contain language instructing the applicator, to remove all farm animals prior from these areas prior to treatment. Within the Directions for Use, directly below the statement "It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling." insert the following new section and text:

#### "GENERAL USE RESTRICTIONS

For use in barns, stables, dairies, pig confinements, and milk and egg handling areas of dairies and chicken houses, all animals must be removed prior to treatment. Treated areas should not be re-occupied by animals, until the area is throughly ventilated. Cover all animal food/feed and watering stations."
