DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

SPI HORSE SPRAY has been especially developed for use on horses. It provides a protective hair coating against flies while imparting a high sheen to the hair when brushed out. I to 2 ounces perhead per day gives adequate protection. Apply by either soft cloth or fine spray mist.

USE TO WIPE ON:

First, brush animal to remove dirt and dust. Moisten (but do not wet to the point of dripping) a soft cloth and rub over the hair. It is best to apply by rubbing against hair growth. Give special attention to legs, shoulders, shanks, neck and facial areas where flies are most often seen. Only a light application is needed. Avoid using an excess amount on your horses. Do not wet skin.

After application, brush out thoroughly to bring out bright sheen on the coat.

Repeat daily or as required.

USE AS A SPRAY:

SPI HORSE SPRAY may be applied as a fine spray mist to stable area and over and around stabled horses for fast paralysis and kill of flies. Do not wet horse's skin or exceed two ounces per application.


SPI PUMP-UP SPRAYER

FOR USE WITH SPI HORSE SPRAY. READ ALL DIRECTIONS ON THE BOTTLE LABEL BEFORE BEGINNING USE OF THE SPI PUMP-UP SPRAYER.

Directions for using the Pump-Up Sprayer:



1. Invert the bottle and shake for 30 seconds. Next unscrewthe red sprayer head and fill the sprayer with SPI Horse Spray. Save the empty bottle and cap for storage of unused product or later disposal. Do not fill the sprayer with more than 30 fluid ounces of product or pumping will become difficult.



Screw the sprayer head snugly on to ensure an air tight seal, but do not over-tighten or the sprayer may crack. Pump the sprayer 10 - 20 full strokes if it is full (30 fl. oz.). More pumping will be needed if the sprayer is partially filled. Do not over-pressurize the sprayer. Maintain pressure by pumping occasionally during use.



Begin spraying by pressing the white trigger. Adjust the white nozzle to deliver a coarse wet spray by turning it open approximately 2 full turns from tightly closed. Do not open nozzle more than 3 full turns or it may come off during use.

Apply the product according to the directions on the bottle label.



when finished spraying, release pressure by slowly unscrewing the red sprayer head. Pour any unused SPI HORSE SPRAY tack into the original container. To keep sprayer in working order, do not store SPI HORSE SPRAY in the sprayer. Do not leave pressurized. Discard empty bottles or unused spray according to the directions on the bottle label.



5. Rinse sprayer thoroughly with clean water, then fill with warm water. Reassemble pump to pressurize and spray to clear tubes, trigger and nozzle. Unscrew the white nozzle completely and hold under strong water spray to clear. Use petroleum jelly to lightly lubricate moving parts and exposed rubber parts. Store in a dry location. Protect from freezing.
