On the basis of information furnished by the registrant, the above named pesticide is hereby registered/reregistered under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act.

Registration is in no way to be construed as an endorsement or recommendation of this product by the Agency. In order to protect health and the environment, the Administrator, on his motion, may at any time suspend or cancel the registration of a pesticide in accordance with the Act. The acceptance of any name in connection with the registration of a product under this Act is not to be construed as giving the registrant a right to exclusive use of the name or to its use if it has been covered by others.

This product is unconditionally registered in accordance with FIFRA sec. 3(c)(5). Once a pesticide is unconditionally registered, however, it is not regarded as permanently acceptable. Unconditional registration does not eliminate the need for continual reassessment of a pesticide. If EPA determines, at any time, that additional data are required to maintain an existing registration, the Agency will require submission of such data under Section 3(c)(2)(B) of the Federal Insecticide Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA).

1. A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.
2. Although most data requirements for the end-use product have been waived, incidences of hypersensitivity must be reported to the Agency in a timely manner.
3. Change the label by revising the EPA Registration Number to read, "EPA Reg. No. 68695-1".
4. Remove the sentence, "Voluntarily tested by Humans ages 14 months to 65 years ....". This statement is considered false and misleading and is prohibited by the Labeling Regulations 40 CFR Part 156.10 (a)(5).
5. Submit five copies of the final printed label for the record.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

Apply Bye-Bye Bugs by holding 4.- 6 inches from body and spray vigorously on to skin and clothing before exposure to flying insects. Reapply every 2 hours or as needed for protection. Reapply after swimming, excessive perspiration, or prolonged activity.
