
1. Add the word "**Pesticide**" before the word Storage in the Storage and Disposal section.

### FIRST AID

## DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

**ENHANCED OIL RECOVERY SYSTEMS:** For controlling slime-forming bacteria, sulfide-producing bacteria, yeasts and fungi in oil field water, polymer or micellar floods, water-disposal systems or other oil field water systems, add 1-80 ppm EC6116A (0.1-6.4 gallons EC6116A per 2400 barrels of water) depending on the severity of contamination. Additions of EC6116A may be made with a metering pump either continuously or intermittently.

Addition of EC6116A may be made at the free water knockouts before or after the injection pumps and injection well headers.

**NOTE:** Add EC6116A separately to the system. In order to avoid decomposition of EC6116A due to the high pH of many additive formulations, do not ad it with other additives.
