

**COPPERCLAD 888** Marine Cladding Wire is an anti-foulant coating, effective against barnacles, zebra mussels, and other marine life when applied using the recommended spray system, and is used in fresh and sea water environments

For use as an antifoulant on boat bottoms and bouys; and stationary marine structure (i.e., dam gates, power plant intake screens and pipes, piers, and bridges.

Only use: **COPPERCLAD 888** recommended spraying system. While spraying or sandblasting surface, always wear a respirator approved by Mining Enforcement and the National Institute of Occupational Safety & Health under the provision of 30 CFR 11. Eye protection is recommended with shade #5 lens. Ear protection must be worn when operator is subjected to excessive noise levels.

**COPPERCLAD 888** Marine Cladding Wire should be thermally sprayed using the International Metalizing Corporation electric arc equipment. Base coats differ for concrete, steel, wood, and fiberglass.

Fiberglass surfaces must have any blisters removed and repaired, and several coats of blister protection resin applied to an even smooth surface. New and old surfaces must have all waxes, old paint and marine growth removed and sanded prior to application.

**COPPERCLAD 888** Marine Cladding is applied with sufficient application technique to provide 2 to 5 mils of thickness. Heavier applications around high wear areas are recommended.

#### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited.

**Pesticide Disposal:** Pesticide wastes are toxic. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate is a violation of Federal law.
