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### **DIRECTIONS FOR USE:**

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Do not apply this product in a way that will contact workers or other persons.

SURCIDE ICP is recommended as an in-container preservative for the control of bacteria and fungi in industrial and household consumer products including allepurpose liguid cleaners; polishers and carpet shampoos; pre-spotters; liquid dishwashing detergents; automotive appearance products such as cleaners, wax and polishes; liquid laundry products; package utility products such as pre-moistened sponges and mops; paints and coatings. Add 0.5 to 4.0 lbs. SURCIDE ICP (227 - 1814 g) to each 1000 lbs. (453.6 kg) of product to be treated with to provide 8 - 53 ppm active isothiazolones. To ensure uniform distribution, slowly disperse SURCIDE ICP into product with agitation. Mix thoroughly until evenly dispersed throughout product.

SURCIDE ICP also preserves and controls the growth of bacteria and fungi in adhesives, polymer emulsions, surfactant solutions, and mineral slurries. Add 0.5 to 4.0 lbs. SURCIDE ICP (227 - 1814 g) to each 1000 lbs. (453.6 kg) of product to be treated to provide 8 - 63 ppm active isothiazolones. To ensure uniform distribution, slowly disperse SURCIDE ICP into product with agitation. Mix thoroughly until evenly dispersed throughout product.

SURCIDE ICP can be used as a preservative for pesticide products applied to growing crops. Add up to 0.14 lbs. to each 1000 lbs. of product (2.25 ppm active isothiazolones).

## STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

### **PESTICIDE STORAGE**

Do not store on side. Avoid creasing or impacting of side walls. The product as supplied evolves gas (largely carbon dioxide) slowly. To prevent buildup of pressure, the product is packaged in a specially vented container. Keep this product in the original container when not in use. Container must be stored and transported in an upright position to prevent spilling the contents through the vent.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL

Pesticide wastes are acutely hazardous. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray or mixture of rinsate is a violation of Federal Law. If these wastes cannot be disposed of by use according to label instructions, contact your State Pesticide or Environmental Control Agency, or the Hazardous Waste representative at the nearest EPA Regional Office for guidance.
