b. Revise the center column to include *"Inhibits the growth of odor causing bacteria and fungi (mold and mildew), bacteria and fungi (mold and mildew) which cause staining and discoloration, and algae. This product does not protect users or others against food-borne or disease causing bacteria or fungi."*

c. Revise the Precautionary Statements to be in agreement with the Label Review Manual as follows. Revise to read exactly as follows:

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
e. Revise the Environmental Hazards statement by adding the following statement to the beginning of this section: *"This pesticide is toxic to fish."*

Use a 6 inch bar for 3 to 6 tons units. Use a 12 inch bar for 6 to 12 tons units, and two 12 inch bars for 12 to 24 ton units, being 1 ton...Change the Pan Purge bar/bars after 6 months..."*

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

## DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Remove clear plastic wrapper. Handle unwrapped product with chemical resistant gloves. Place **PAN PURGE** in air conditioner condensate pan, at the end farthest from the drain opening. Use a 3 inch bar for up to 3 tons A/C system; 6 inches between 3 and 6 tons, 12 inches from 6 to 12 tons and 24 inches for 12 to 24 tons, being 1 ton equivalent to 12000 BTU. Change the **PAN PURGE** bars after 6 months and replace with a new one. Wash hands thoroughly after handling **PAN PURGE**.
