



Directions for Use:

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product inconsistent with its labeling.
Aqua Select Universal Filter Cartridge Instruction for use:

1. Remove filter from polybag and immerse in cold water for 10-15 minutes to activate filter. Rinse briefly and insert in funnel opening of water filter system. Position the arrow marked on the date the filter contents should be replaced (approx. 30 days from insertion.)
2. Fill with water. Use with cold water only. Use the first water produced with a new filter cartridge for water flowers etc., as the activated carbon particles may make the water cloudy.
3. This product is designed to remove objectionable tastes, odors, and colors from municipally treated tap water.
 - The Aqua Select filter is NOT to be used with water that is microbiologically unsafe or of unknown quality without adequate disinfection before or after the system.
 - Filter cartridge is sufficient for up to 35 gallons depending on water hardness. To ensure maximum efficiency process no more than 5 pitchers per day.
 - If no water flows into the carafe after inserting filter, there could be air bubbles forming in the filter. Remove cartridge, shake gently and replace.
