- a. Change the product registration number to "EPA Reg. No. 69061-12"
- b. Make the following label revisions:


- 1. In the 2nd sentence of the statement "Have the product container ...," please note that the "1-800-xxx-xxxx" number listed must be available twenty-four (24) hours per day, seven (7) days per week for answering and responding to any medical emergencies or health concerns.
- 2. In the 1st sentence of the 5th bullet in the Directions for Use section, General Precautions and Use Restrictions subsection, delete the word "this" and re-insert the word "this" immediately following the word "applying."
- 3. Data deficiencies were identified for storage stability and corrosion characteristics in the product chemistry review for this product. Therefore, Sivad Manufacturing & Packaging, Inc. is obligated to submit a One Year Storage Stability (830.6317) study and a Corrosion Characteristics (830.6320) study on this product in support of this registration within one (1) year from the date of this registration.

- 3. Submit two (2) copies of the revised final printed label for the record before the product is released for shipment.

Sivad Manufacturing & Packaging, Inc. should note that a notice of availability of EPA's reregistration eligibility decision (RED) document for products containing pyrethrins was published in the *Federal Register* on July 26, 2006 (Volume 71, Number 143, Pages 42387-42389). In addition, EPA's RED for products containing piperonyl butoxide was published in the *Federal Register* on July 26, 2006 (Volume 71, Number 143, Pages 42385-42386). Further, EPA's RED for products containing MGK® 264 was published in the *Federal Register* on July 26, 2006 (Volume 71, Number 143, Pages 42381-42383). As a result, additional data and/or labeling changes may be required for products containing pyrethrins, piperonyl butoxide and MGK® 264.

If the above conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

- Do not repeat treatment for 7 days.
- Do not use on pets less than 12 weeks old.
- Remove pets, birds and cover fish aquariums before application.
- Consult veterinarian before ~~this~~ applying product on medicated, debilitated, aged pregnant or nursing animals. Certain medications can interact with pesticides. Consult a veterinarian before using on medicated animals.
- Sensitivities may occur after using ANY pesticide for pets. If signs of sensitivity occur, bathe your pet with mild soap and water and rinse with large amounts of water. If signs continue, consult a veterinarian immediately.

READ ENTIRE LABEL BEFORE EACH USE. USE ONLY IN A WELL VENTILATED AREA. USE ONLY ON HORSES, DOGS AND CATS.

HOW TO USE: For use on horses, dogs and cats for the control of fleas and ticks. Wet the animals coat for 2-3 minutes with warm water. Apply shampoo on head and ears and lather. Then repeat procedure with neck, chest, middle and hindquarters, finishing with the legs last and paying special attention to the footpads (between the toes) and underbody areas. Wash head and ear areas carefully, making sure to keep shampoo out of the animals eyes. NOTE: A drop of glycerin in each eye before bathing may prevent or reduce irritation if the shampoo gets in the animal's eyes. Pay special attention to the base of the tail, as it is a place frequented by fleas. Fully lather animal and let rather remain for 5 minutes before rinsing thoroughly with water. NOTE: This final step is an important part of grooming procedure.

For small dogs and cats less than 15 pounds, wrapping the animal in a towel for several minutes to absorb moisture is advised. This will also allow dying fleas and ticks to crawl off animal into towel before drying animal with towel or blow dryer.

Flea and tick control on the animal is only part of the solution to the problem. The inside of the house and the outdoor area used by the animal must also be treated for complete control.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage and disposal

Pesticide storage: Store in a cool, dry place inaccessible to pets and children.

Pesticide disposal: **If empty:** Do not reuse container. Place in trash or offer for recycling if available. **If partially filled:** Call your local solid waste agency or 1-800-CLEANUP for disposal instructions. Never place unused product down any indoor or outdoor drains.
