
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3. Under the heading "To Drive Raccoons from Nests", the heading and paragraph should be replaced with the following:

To Drive Raccoons from Den Sites: When a den is found, surround it with GREEN SCREEN BAGS. Place BAGS as close as possible to the den. Since raccoons are nocturnal animals, product should be in place in the early evening when the raccoon is absent. Do not apply when raccoon is present.

4. Submit five copies of the revised final printed label for the record.

Unconditional registration does not eliminate the need for continual reassessment of a pesticide. If EPA determines, at any time, that additional data are required to maintain in effect an existing registration, the Agency will require submission of such data under Section 3(c)(2)(B) of the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA).

General Application Information - Hang GREEN SCREEN BAGS from plants, stakes, trees or other suitable items around vegetation to discourage deer, rabbits and raccoons from browsing. Hang BAGS a maximum of 2 feet apart in rows along a fence. Suspend one BAG on every tree or bush under 6 feet and two BAGS on taller vegetation. For deer, BAGS should be hanged 3 to 4½ feet from the ground and 1½ feet for rabbits and raccoons. If severe browsing damage exists, place BAGS closer together. GREEN SCREEN BAGS are odor offensive to wildlife and should remain FULLY EXPOSED. Can be used for home and garden.

To Drive Raccoons from Nests: When a nest is found, surround it with GREEN SCREEN BAGS. Place BAGS as close as possible to the nest. Since raccoons are nocturnal animals, product should be in place in the early evening when the raccoon is absent. Do not apply when raccoon is present.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

GENERAL: For best results use within one year of opening package. Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

STORAGE: Store in original container, in a cool, dry location.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Completely empty container into application equipment. Then offer for recycling, reconditioning or dispose of empty container in a sanitary landfill or by incineration, or, if allowed by state and local authorities, by burning.
