DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling

MEXEL 432 is to be used for the control of mollusks, including zebra mussels and clams, only in closed delivery systems of non-potable industrial waters. Sites of application do not include fresh water cooling tower systems.

The product may be applied to maintain clean systems or to treat systems that are already fouled. Normal frequency of treatment is once per day or as needed to maintain control. The amount of the daily dose is determined by the amount of internal surface area to be protected and is calculated at approximately 0.033 pounds per 100 square feet of surface per day. This dose is injected into the circulating water at a rate to achieve a concentration of 1-4 ppm, i.e. 1-4 pints of product for each 120,000 gallons of water.
