- D. Add the non-FIFRA advisory statement - "Not intended for human consumption".



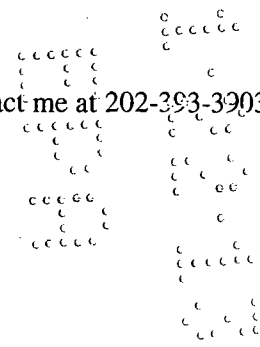
