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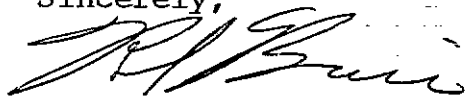

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

Danger. Corrosive. Causes irreversible eye damage or skin burns. May be fatal if absorbed through skin. Harmful if swallowed or inhaled. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Avoid breathing spray mist. Wear goggles or face shield. Wear protective clothing and rubber gloves. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking or using tobacco. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse.

FIRST AID

If swallowed: Call physician or Poison Control Center. Do not induce vomiting. Drink large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol.

If on skin: Wash with plenty of soap and water. Get medical attention.

If inhaled: Remove victim to fresh air. If not breathing, give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth. Get medical attention.

If in eyes: Hold eyelids open and flush with steady, gentle stream of water for 15 minutes. Get medical attention.

NOTE TO PHYSICIANS

Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate use of gastric lavage.

Uses: All precleaned, hard, nonporous surfaces of wood, glass, plastic, dental acrylic, composite, porcelain, fiber glass, metal (except aluminum, brass, copper, and mild steel), ear rings, dental pumice, pans, sinks, toilet areas, shower tiles, tubs, and laboratory benches. For use outside of the mouth: denture brushes and dental impressions. **Do not allow contact time on metals to exceed 10 minutes.**

5-Minute Kill time: Tuberculocidal, Bactericidal, Fungicidal, and Virucidal* including *Mycobacterium tuberculosis* BCG, *Trichophyton mentagrophytes* (pathogenic fungi), *Staphylococcus aureus*, *Salmonella choleraesius*, *Pseudomonas aeruginosa*, *Herpes simplex* Type 2, Poliovirus Type 1, Adenovirus Type 2, Rhinovirus Type 2, and Influenza A/2 (hong kong) on hard, non-porous inanimate surfaces.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

MIXING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Pour entire contents of 15 ml bottles of solutions 'A' and 'B' into mixing container 'C', which is the dark container.
2. Place bottle cap back on 'C' and wait 5 minutes for reaction to take place.
3. Now fill mixing container 'C' with 470 ml demineralized water.
4. It is now ready to use and can be transferred to a plastic container (never metal) to soak objects to be disinfected or to a spray bottle for applications on flat surfaces.
5. Prepare fresh solution prior to each use.

TO DISINFECT:

1. Wash the object or surface thoroughly with soap and water.
2. The object or surface to be disinfected must be immersed in the Parox solution and all surfaces wet thoroughly for 5 minutes.
3. To remove the Parox solution simply rinse or wipe off.

FOR TUBERCULOCIDAL USE:

Thoroughly preclean the surfaces prior to application of the product. Effective at 20°C for 5 minutes.

This product is not to be used as a terminal sterilant/high level disinfectant on any surface or instrument that (1) is introduced directly into the human body, either into or in contact with the bloodstream or normally sterile areas of the body, or (2) contacts intact mucous membranes but which does not ordinarily penetrate the blood barrier or otherwise enter normally sterile areas of the body. This product

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may be used to preclean or decontaminate critical or semi-critical medical devices prior to sterilization or high level disinfection.

TO CLEAN TOILET BOWL:

Remove residual toilet bowl water prior to applying the use solution. Thoroughly swab all bowl surfaces with use solution, making sure to get under the rim.

Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

Storage: Store unmixed product in a cool dry place away from excessive heat. Product diluted for use should not be kept beyond 24 hours.

Disposal: Used and unused product that has been diluted for use may be disposed of by pouring down the drain. Triple rinse containers and place in the trash. Wrap undiluted product in several layers of newspaper and place in the trash.
