Hazard to Humans and Domestic Animals

**CAUTION:**

Harmful if swallowed. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Harmful if absorbed through skin. Causes eye irritation. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. Harmful if inhaled. Avoid breathing dust. Remove contaminated clothing and wash clothing before reuse.

**STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT:****N-Methyl Carbamate**

- **IF SWALLOWED:** Call a physician or Poison Control Center. Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger, or if available by administering syrup of ipecac. If person is unconscious, do not give anything by mouth and do not induce vomiting.
- IF ON SKIN:** Wash with plenty of soap and water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.
- IF INHALED:** Remove victim to fresh air. If not breathing, give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth. Get medical attention.
- IF IN EYES:** Flush eyes with plenty of water. Call a physician if irritation persists.
- NOTE TO PHYSICIAN:** Carbaryl is a moderate reversible cholinesterase inhibitor. Atropine is antidotal.

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE:**

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

For use only in the bedding of cats and dogs for control of ticks & fleas. Do not use with pregnant cats or dogs. Do not use in bedding of cats with kittens, or dogs with puppies, less than 5 weeks of age.

1. Before removing tape from pet pad, shake and fluff to distribute powder evenly.
2. Remove tape, place pet pad, with holes up, in pillow case or other similar fabric and place securely in pet's bedding.
3. Wash bedding cover frequently.
4. Do not wash pet pad.

To renew effectiveness of pet pad, once every two weeks:

1. Remove pet pad from bedding.
2. Place tape securely over holes to prevent powder from escaping.
3. Shake and fluff to redistribute powder.
4. Return to bedding per instructions.

**STORAGE & DISPOSAL:**

When not in use, store in original container away from children. When disposing, securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.
