On March 18, 1997, we received a copy of your final printed labeling, which was not accompanied by a cover letter. In our February 27, 1997, Notice of Registration, we approved this product, subject to certain labeling changes. As indicated in the Notice:

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

When we reviewed your final printed labeling, the text departed from the version accepted on February 27, 1997. In the future, if you wish to change the wording of approved labeling, you need to submit three (3) copies of proposed labeling and an explanation for the proposed changes. Then we will review your revisions and notify you by letter if the proposed changes are acceptable. If you simply make labeling changes and inform us after the fact, then you risk having a misbranded product, subject to enforcement action.

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable provided that you make the following changes and submit one (1) copy to us before you ship your product:

#### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

**Use Restrictions:** This product may be used in yards around homes and other buildings to discourage gray squirrels, red squirrels, fox squirrels and chipmunks from feeding on seeds and other dry feed placed in feeders or on the ground to feed wild birds.

Mixing Directions: Wearing eye protection and gloves at an <u>outdoor</u>, wind-protected location, mix 1/2 cup of vegetable oil and 3 tablespoons of PREVENT in a small, self-closing plastic package or container with a tight lid. Then add oily mixture to 5 lbs of bird food in a container with a securable top, large enough to facilitate mixing. Close top of container securely and shake container thoroughly, inverting the container occasionally to promote complete mixing.

Application Directions: Using gloves, fill feeders or place treated feed on ground in the manner appropriate for the species of birds that you are trying to feed. Repeat use of treated feed if squirrels and chipmunks return.

[Note that, since you will not be marketing your product in 3 oz. self-closing subpackages as originally assumed, which would have reduced possible exposure of the product to those mixing it, we had to modify the mixing directions to direct mixers to supply all their own mixing containers.]

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions. A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records.
