Use one part Viodine per every eleven parts of whole blood contained in the suction canister. Viodine should be introduced 30 minutes before disposal. After procedure, empty Viodine into canister in one of two ways: 1) With the suction running, insert the suction wand or patient tubing into the Viodine bottle and drain; or, 2) open the accessory port and pour the contents of the Viodine bottle completely into the canister. Re-cap canister and mix thoroughly. Transport canister to hopper and dispose of contents according to institutional procedure. Dispose of empty canister according to institutional procedure.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL: Do not store below 0°F. Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Pesticide wastes are hazardous. Impsoper disposal of excess pesticides or rinsate is a violation of Federal Law. Bottle Disposal: Triple rinse.
