On the basis of information furnished by the registrant, the above named pesticide is hereby registered/reregistered under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act.

Registration is in no way to be construed as an endorsement or recommendation of this product by the Agency. In order to protect health and the environment, the Administrator, on his motion, may at any time suspend or cancel the registration of a pesticide in accordance with the Act. The acceptance of any name in connection with the registration of a product under this Act is not to be construed as giving the registrant a right to exclusive use of the name or to its use if it has been covered by others.

This product is unconditionally registered in accordance with FIFRA sec. 3(c)(5). Once a pesticide is registered, however, it is not regarded as permanently acceptable. Registration does not eliminate the need for continual reassessment of pesticides. If the Agency determines that, at any time, additional data are required to maintain in effect an existing registration, the Agency will require submission of such data under FIFRA section (3)(c)(2)(B).

1. Make the following label change:
  - a. Add the phrase "EPA Registration Number 69261-1" to the label.
  - b. Revise the ingredient statement as follows:
 

Active Ingredients:.....100%  
Diatomaceous Earth (including silicon dioxide, other oxides and moisture)
  - c. Delete the statement "contains amorphous silica" or change it to "contains amorphous silicon dioxide" since amorphous silica is considered an active ingredient and is not a part of the product formulation.

- d. The net weight or net content of product should appear on the lower third of the front label panel.
- e. Add the section entitled "Environmental Hazards" and add the following statements:

Do not discharge effluent containing this product into lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans or other waters unless in accordance with the requirements of a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit and the permitting authority has been notified in writing prior to discharge. Do not discharge effluent containing this product to sewer systems without previously notifying the local sewage treatment plant authority. For guidance contact your State Water Board or Regional Office of the EPA. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes."

- e. Add the following statement to the Directions for Use section:

For Formulation into end-use insecticide products intended only for terrestrial food/feed crops; terrestrial non-food crops, outdoor sites, indoor food/non-food sites.

- f. Revise the Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals to read as follows:

Causes moderate eye irritation. Avoid contact with eyes or clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Use adequate ventilation and avoid breathing dust. For prolonged exposure to dust, use a suitable dust mask approved by NIOSH/MSHA.

- g. The statement, "It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.", must appear directly under the heading entitled Directions For Use.

3. Submit two copies of the revised final printed label for the record. Refer to the A-79 enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.
