 - b. Delete the statement "Not for Retail Sale" This is in conflict with the formulator's exemption statement (CFR 40 Section 152.85) which allows other applicants to purchase pesticide products provided they make appropriate offers to pay for use of data
- Submit a revised Confidential Statement of Formula (CSF) listing the trace element oxides at 10%.
 Refer to the CSF submitted for 62961-1 and cover letter dated February 17, 1997.
- 4. Submit two (2) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.
