Dear Mr. Messina:

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable with the following label revision provision(s):

Amendments to Dog Spot-On Product Registrations:

- 1. This registration is now time-limited, and will expire 2 years from the date of this letter. More specifically, this registration will expire on September 4, 2016.
- 2. If the Agency determines that future mitigation measures are necessary for all pet spot-on products, EPA will inform registrants. If mitigation measures are necessary, EPA may take regulatory action.
- 3. Please consider limiting the formulations of this product to one basic confidential statement of formula. The Agency may require this in the future. In addition, it is possible that no additional alternate formulations or minor formulation amendments will be approved for this product in the future.
- 4. You must submit quarterly enhanced incident reports and quarterly sales information in doses sold for this product beginning October 1, 2014. Please flag any Confidential Business Information as such. Enhanced incident reporting and quarterly sales information should be submitted to the Product Manager. The following is a list of information that must be included in the quarterly reports for each incident:
 - EPA Registration Number
 - Product name (brand name)
 - Lot #
 - Where purchased: Internet, store, veterinarian.
 - Active ingredient(s)
 - Weight range for product
 - Date on which incident occurred. (mm/dd/yyyy)
 - State in which the incident occurred. (Standard 2 letter abbreviation)
 - Registrant case #
 - Species: Dog, cat, other (specify).
 - Breed: (As reported by pet owner)
 - Age: Months or years.
 - Sex: M, F, or neutered.

Conditions of Acceptance/Amendments to Dog Spot-On Product Registrations, continued:

- Weight: Pounds.
- Primary Route of Exposure: Dermal, oral, other animal, inhalation, other.
- Body System: Neurological, dermatological, GI, respiratory, ocular, other.
- Major signs noted with separate column for each sign, using standard terminology.
- Time to Onset: (Hours, days)
- Treated by veterinarian: Yes or No
- First time product used: Yes or No
- Misuse: Use on incorrect species, overdose, too frequent dosing, other (describe).
- Any known pre-condition.
- EPA Severity Code: Death, major, moderate, minor.
- Outcome: Died, recovered, still treated, unknown.
- 5. Along with the enhanced incident reporting, you must submit an analysis of the incidents seen, to include the following details:
 - All incidents should be reported, including all minor dermal and ocular irritation reports.
 - Summary table for dogs showing number of incidents of each severity code for each route of exposure. Each incident should only be reported once. If one incident has several routes of exposure, the order should be ocular > oral > dermal. In other words, an incident with both oral and dermal exposure would be reported as oral exposure, and an incident with both ocular and oral exposure would be reported as ocular exposure.
 - Summary table for dogs showing number of incidents that are believed due to secondary exposure (e.g., multipet households).
 - A summary table for dogs showing number of incidents for each severity code for these age ranges: <3 months, 3-6 months, 6-9 months, 9-12 months, 1 yr, 2 yr, 3 yr, 4 yr, 5 yr, 6 yr, 7 yr, 8 yr, 9 yr, 10 yr, 11 yr, 12 yr, 13 yr, 14 yr, 15 yr, >15 yr.
 - A summary table showing the number of dog incidents for each severity code for each pet weight range on the product label.
 - A summary table for dog weight showing number of incidents for each product weight range. This table should show number of incidents in dogs weighing less than that product weight range, number of incidents in dogs in lower half of weight range, number of incidents in dogs in upper half of weight range, and dogs weighing more than the product weight range.
 - Table showing number of incidents for each cat breed.
 - Table showing number of incidents in dogs for each clinical sign.
 - Table showing number of incidents in dogs for each organ system.
 - Report aggregate incidents, but do not combine moderate and minor incidents.

You must submit one copy of the final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment with the new labeling. In accordance with 40 CFR 152.130(c), you may distribute or sell this product under the previously approved labeling for 18 months from the date of this letter. After 18 months, you may only distribute or sell this product if it bears this new revised labeling or subsequently approved labeling. "To distribute or sell" is defined under FIFRA section 2(gg) and its implementing regulation at 40 CFR 152.3.

Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions. If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with section 6(e) of FIFRA. Copies of your updated master label stamped "Accepted" and the review for minimum weight treated are enclosed for your records. Please note that this letter does not supersede anything contained within the Agency's letter dated September 30, 2011 and the original conditions of acceptance detailed in the Agency's Notice of Registration dated April 4, 2000. The conclusion date for the subject time-limited product registration is September 4, 2016.

Do not use on puppies under 6 months of age or less than [7] [33] lbs. Use entire contents of tube vial on each dog. [Do not split one tube between dogs.] Do not use multiple tubes on one dog. Weigh your dog to be sure you are applying the right dose formulated for the weight of your dog. Separate the treated dog from all other dogs and cats for 24 hours after treatment has been applied. Treated dogs should not be allowed to go swimming for 12 hours following treatment. Repeat applications may be made as necessary, but do not apply at intervals less than 7 days.

1. Remove product tube from the package. Holding tube with top end pointing up and away from the face and body, cut off top end. 2. Use open end to part the dog's coat to expose the skin between the shoulder blades, at the nape of the neck. 3. Squeeze the entire contents of one tube onto exposed skin. If the dog's coat is subsequently wetted, such as when shampooing, the 4 week period of protection may be reduced.

ONLY for dogs weighing over 33 lb., the contents of this package provides a [3 months'] [1 month] supply. **Do not apply to dogs weighing less than 33 lbs**.

1. Remove product tube from the package. Holding tube with top end pointing up and away from the face and body, cut off top end. 2. Use open end to part the dog's coat to expose the skin between the shoulder blades, at the nape of the neck, then squeeze approximately one-half the contents of one tube onto the exposed skin. 3. Next, part the dog's coat at the base of the tail, then squeeze the remaining contents of the tube onto exposed skin. If the dog's coat is subsequently wetted, such as when shampooing, the 4 week period of protection may be reduced.

Additional precautions to protect your dog: 1. Do not massage the drops into the dog's skin. Avoid applying to the dog's fur. 2. Do not administer any other flea control product to your dog during the 4 week period of protection. 3. Retreat after 28 days if infestation is apparent.

Additional precautions to protect your family: Do not allow children to play with tubes. A dog treated with this product should not sleep with people, particularly children, for 8 hours immediately following treatment. Do not handle the area of application for 3 to 6 hours following treatment.

[What else you must do: Treating your dog's basket and favorite sleeping areas with a suitable insecticidal product labeled for this use and vacuuming these areas regularly will also help to remove fleas and ticks. Consult your veterinarian for product suggestions.]


